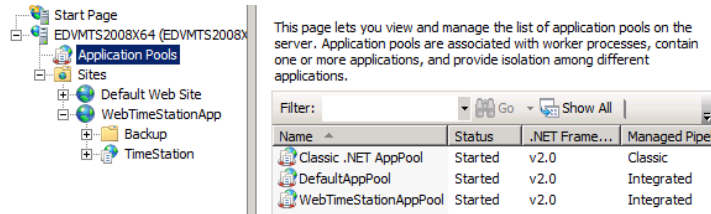


Install WebTimeStation on a 64-bit Server Operating System

Note: IIS must be installed before getting started.

Note: Gradience TimeClock must be installed and have an Enterprise license entered.

- Double-click the zip file you received and drag **WebTimeStationManualInstall** folder to the desktop.
- Open an elevated command prompt and type the change directory command to point to: **windows\microsoft.net\framework64\v2.0.50727** and in the command prompt type **aspnet_regiis.exe /u** and after completion type **aspnet_regiis.exe /i**
- Run **Firebird_ODBC_2.0.0.151_x64.exe** (found in WebTimeStationManualInstall\Prep)
- Copy **gds32.dll** (found in WebTimeStationManualInstall\Prep) to **c:\windows\SysWOW64** and/or **c:\windows\system32**
- Open IIS and add a new **Application Pool** named **WebTimeStationAppPool**
- Right-click the app pool, select Advanced Settings and Enable 32-Bit Applications to **True** and configure **Identity** under **Process Model to Network Service**
- Copy the **WebTimeStationManualInstall\WebTimeStation** folder and paste it in **c:\inetpub\wwwroot**
- In IIS Manager add a website named **WebTimeStationApp** and set the application pool to **WebTimeStationAppPool**, binder/bindings is the IP address of server and the physical path is the complete path to the HRWARE.GDB database file.
- Under the **WebTimeStationApp** site add an application named **TimeStation**. Set the application pool to **WebTimeStationAppPool**, physical path is **c:\inetpub\wwwroot\webtimestationsmanualinstallweb\webtimestation** and virtual path is **TimeStation**, directory browsing must be enabled as well.
- Edit the **web.config** file located in **c:\inetpub\wwwroot\webtimestationsmanualinstallweb\webtimestation** and verify that the path line is pointing to your **HRWARE.GDB** file and **dbname=localhost** or your server name/server IP. Example shown below:

- Open a browser and navigate to <http://127.0.0.1/TimeStation> (where 127.0.0.1 is your server IP/domain)

NOTE: If you're testing this server side make sure to temporarily turn off Internet Explorer's Enhanced Security.(**Server Manager > Configure IE ESC**)
